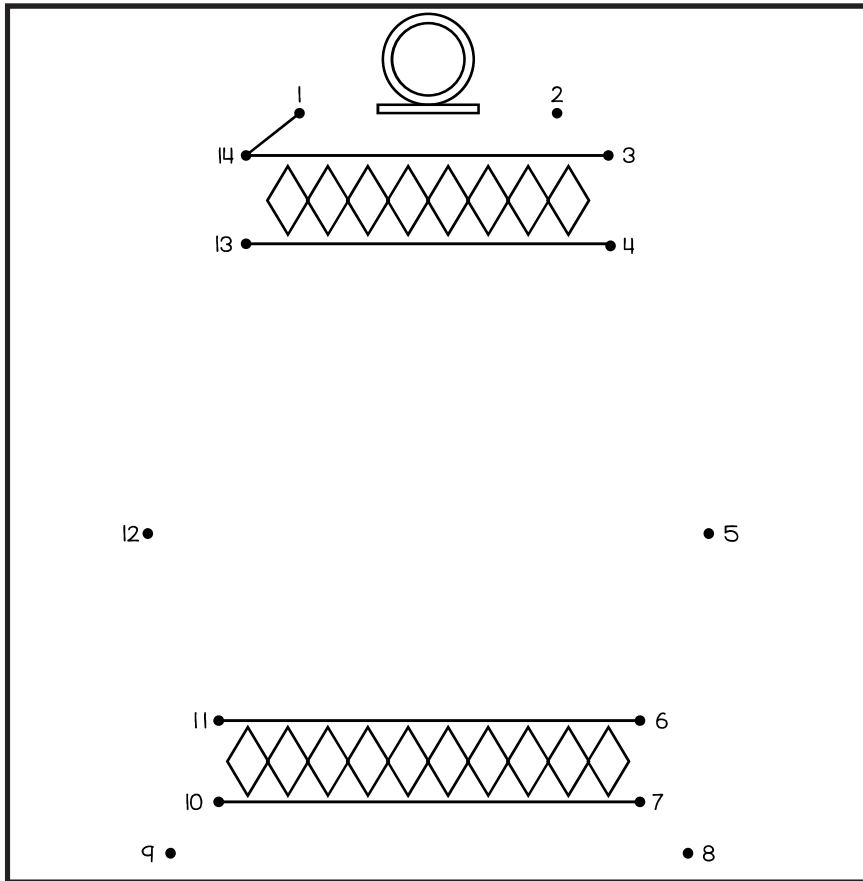


# CONNECT the DOTS
